Weekends and holidays are so busy you'll find it difficult to park in Caloundra. The answer is to park in a quiet location, Golden Beach or Moffat are ideal, and start the Coastal Pathway there.

The Moffat to Kings Beach section has a couple of climbs but the spectacular views including the iconic Glass House Mountains give you every reason to stop and rest.

You'll be impressed by the high quality infrastructure along Kings Beach to Bulcock Beach. It's an aquatic playground including spray park, water fountains and salt water public pool built over the rocks.
