Foreshore Trail

The late Eddie Santagiuliana was a Redland Shire councillor and Mayor between 1982 and 2001. This foreshore trail is named in his honour.

The pathway passes through a variety of landscapes including melaleuca wetland, mangroves, open bush and sports fields. Links through quiet, picturesque streets show off the rich red soil of Bayside suburbs.

Oyster Point has been a recreation reserve since 1889 and was a popular swimming spot especially when a jetty and swimming enclosure (now dismantled) were built in the 1930s.

Recommended day trip

The whole Eddie Santagiuliana Way is a signed trail and ideal as a longer ride.

Add a challenge by starting at Cleveland Point to the north then riding all the way to Victoria Point to the south. You'll need to connect Thornlands Road to Beveridge Road where two impressive bridges will take you across to School Road and Point Halloran.
