## Where to Mountain Bike in South East Queensland

The most remarkable feature of the trails is both beginners and experts are provided for. The trails are fairly easy but very difficult skills have been built on optional side trails.

Sweet Sugar (4.8km) is very long and very popular with a huge number of built features: many log roll-overs, timber ramps and bridges. Long log rides, a seesaw and suspension bridge and two challenging skills areas are attached.

Sugar Rush (450m) is an old, gently descending fire road that has been re-shaped with many jumps. It is also an easy ride up to the trail head on Sugar Bag Road. Syrup (670m) is a contoured flowing trail with small jumps; an easy descent or climb for most riders. Honeycomb (1km) is a smooth, fast downhill which is also used as a climb.

Golden Rough (780m) is very well designed and constructed. An entertaining, narrow trail it has short descents and rises while following the contour. Small jumps, rock gardens and other features add interest.

Candy Store is for highly skilled riders looking for extreme challenge! Near vertical boulders with skinny ramps, rocky drops, skinny log rides and more make this an amazing playground, if you dare.
